Local Law 97 lets my building comply with low carbon gas in the boiler I already own.

The law gives you more than one way.

We support Local Law 97 as written... no changes necessary. We're asking the City to use all of it. The law scores your building by the energy you use, times a "**number**" for each fuel. The Council wrote in that "**number**" for electricity, gas, oil and steam, and told the Buildings Commissioner to set it for every other alternative fuel (§ 28-320.3.1.1(7)). DOB set one for biofuels. It hasn't set one for low carbon gas. It was written into the original and existing law!

What to do. Call your elected official and ask that they kindly request our friends at the DOB set the "**number**" as the law directs them to. Then ask your gas supplier about Low Carbon Gas. You don't have to buy ours.
